The Bristol Waterworks (Charges) Order 1973

13th December 1973 Made

Coming into Operation 1st January 1974

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 40 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows: ---

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Bristol Waterworks (Charges) Citation Order 1973, and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1974.

- (2) The Bristol Waterworks Acts and Orders 1862 to 1971 and this order may be cited together as the Bristol Waterworks Acts and Orders 1863 to 1973.
 - 2.—(1) In this order, unless the context otherwise requires— "the Company" means the Bristol Waterworks Company;

Interpretation.

"the undertaking" means the undertaking of the Company as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

- (2) Unless the context otherwise requires, any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- 3. During the period beginning with the date of coming into operation Alteration of this order and ending on 31st March 1974 the prescribed maximum of charges charge which the Company may make for a supply of water by meter for metered shall be 31.5p per thousand gallons instead of five shillings and sixpence per thousand gallons as provided by section 3 of the Bristol Waterworks (Charges) Order 1967(c).
