## The Regional Development Grants (Qualifying Activities)

## Order 1973

<i>Made</i>	- - -	15th February 1973
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>		26th February 1973
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		27th February 1973

The Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 3(2) of the Industry Act 1972(a) and with the consent of the Treasury hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(2) This Order may be cited as the Regional Development Grants (Qualifying Activities) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 27th February 1973.

2. For the purposes of Part I of the Industry Act 1972 the descriptions of qualifying activities in subsection 2(a) of section 2 of that Act shall be varied by omitting from minimum list heading 212 in Order III of the Standard Industrial Classification (Bread and Flour Confectionery) the words from “Production” to the end of the heading.
