The Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations 1973

Made - - - 26th February 1973

Laid before Parliament 9th March 1973

Coming into Operation 1st April 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 80(11) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1973.

2. In these Regulations a reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) Regulations 1970(b), as amended(c).

3. In a case in which a notice under subsection (2) of section 80 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, offering the opportunity of the discharge of any liability to conviction of an offence to which that section applies by payment of a fixed penalty has been given or affixed under the said section before the coming into operation of these Regulations, the principal Regulations shall have effect as if these Regulations had not been made.

4. For the first entry in Schedule 3 to the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the entry set out below:—

Area in which offence was committed	Clerk to whom payment is to be made
The Bedfordshire and Luton police area.	The clerk to the justices for the Bedford petty sessional division.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the provisions of the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) Regulations 1970 which specify the clerk to whom a fixed penalty is payable.

They provide that where the offence is alleged to have been committed in the Bedfordshire and Luton police area payment shall be made to the clerk to the justices for the Bedford petty sessional division.
