The Counter-Inflation (Wages Councils) (No. 2) Order 1973

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraphs 4(2) and 5(1) of the Schedule to the Counter-Inflation (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the 1972 Act"), as amended by paragraph 10(3) of Schedule 3 to the Counter-Inflation Act 1973(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Counter-Inflation (Wages Councils) (No. 2) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 31st March 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Continuation of the Counter-Inflation (Wages Councils) Orders

2. The modifications of the wages regulation orders set out in the Schedule to the Counter-Inflation (Wages Councils) Order 1972(d), as varied by the Counter-Inflation (Wages Councils) Order 1973(e), and in Schedule 2 to the Counter-Inflation (Wages Councils) Order 1973 shall, in relation to remuneration for work during any period before section 2 of the 1972 Act ceases to have effect, continue in force notwithstanding the lapse of section 2 of the 1972 Act and shall so continue after 29th April 1973.
