JURIES

The Jurors (Paying Officer) (Scotland) Regulations 1973

Made - - - - - 27th March 1973

Coming into Operation 1st April 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 25(1) and 32(1) of the Juries Act 1949(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service whose consent is required by the said section 32(1) as read with the Minister for the Civil Service Order 1971(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Jurors (Paying Officer) (Scotland) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. For the purposes of section 25(1)(a) of the Juries Act 1949 (which relates to the payment for service at a sitting of the High Court of Justiciary at Edinburgh or in the Court of Session) there shall be substituted for the reference to the King's and Lord Treasurer's Remembrancer a reference to the Director, Scottish Courts Administration.

These Regulations transfer the responsibility for the payment of jurors in respect of service at the High Court of Justiciary at Edinburgh or in the Court of Session from the Queen's and Lord Treasurer's Remembrancer to the Director of the Scottish Courts Administration.
