CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 7) Order 1973

Made - - - - - 29th March 1973

Laid before the House of Commons 30th March 1973

Coming into Operation 1st April 1973

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 3(6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State (b), hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 7) Order 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 1st April 1973.

2.—(1) Until the beginning of 3rd July 1973 or, in the case of goods in relation to which an earlier day is specified in the Schedule to this Order, until the beginning of that day, any import duty which is for the time being chargeable on goods of a heading of the Customs Tariff 1959 specified in that Schedule shall not be chargeable in respect of goods of any description there specified in relation to that heading.

(2) Any entry in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order shall be taken to comprise all goods which would be classified under an entry in the same terms constituting a subheading (other than the final subheading) in the relevant heading in the Customs Tariff 1959.

3. For the purposes of classification under the Customs Tariff 1959, insofar as that depends on the rate of duty, any goods to which Article 2(1) above applies shall be treated as chargeable with the same duty as if this Order had not been made.

SCHEDULE

GOODS TEMPORARILY EXEMPT FROM IMPORT DUTY

<i>Tariff heading</i>	<i>Description</i>
73.08	Iron or steel coils for re-rolling (until 3rd July 1973)
73.13	Sheets or plates of iron or steel, cold-rolled but not coated or otherwise worked (until 3rd July 1973) Sheets or plates of iron or steel, in coils, hot-rolled but not coated or otherwise worked (until 3rd July 1973)
73.21	Steel piles in the form of longitudinally welded steel tubes, having an outside diameter of not less than 1200 millimetres and not more than 1240 millimetres, of a wall thickness of not less than 20 millimetres and not more than 55 millimetres of a length of not less than 31,300 millimetres and not more than 32,500 millimetres; each tube having two sets of 16 lengths of mild steel angle iron in the form of splines, welded longitudinally around the periphery at two levels towards one end, each spline being of a length of not less than 1040 millimetres and not more than 2000 millimetres (until 3rd May 1973)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order provides that the goods listed in the Schedule shall be exempt from import duty until 3rd July 1973 or until such earlier date as is specified in the Schedule.
