The Rating of Industry (Scotland) Order 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 10(2) of the Local Government (Financial Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1963(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Rating of Industry (Scotland) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on the day following the day on which it is approved by resolution of the Commons House of Parliament.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. In respect of the years 1973/74 and 1974/75, the rateable value of any industrial or freight transport lands and heritages so far as occupied and used or treated as occupied and used for industrial or freight transport purposes shall be the amount produced by deducting from the net annual value thereof fifty per cent. of that value.
