The Beef Cow (Scotland) (Amendment) Scheme 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 12 of the Agriculture Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the approval of the Treasury, I hereby make the following scheme:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This scheme, which may be cited as the Beef Cow (Scotland) (Amendment) Scheme 1973, shall be construed as one with the Beef Cow (Scotland) Scheme 1972(b) (in this scheme referred to as “the principal scheme”) and shall come into operation on 1st June 1973.

Amendment of the Principal Scheme

2. Paragraph 2(1) of the principal scheme shall be amended by deleting all reference to “December Return” and by substituting for the definition of “June Return” the following definition:—

“ ‘June Return’ means the return of information required by the Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Agriculture Act 1947(c) as amended by the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1972(d) to be made by occupiers of land used for agriculture with respect to a date in June.”

3.—(1) Paragraph 6(b) of the principal scheme shall be amended to read—
“the number of cows and in-calf heifers comprised in the herd on the 4th day in the immediately preceding December,”

(2) The words “or no such December” shall be deleted from sub-paragraph (i) of the proviso to paragraph 6.

(3) In paragraph 7(1)(c) of the principal scheme, the words “date of the December Return made in that period” shall be deleted and there shall be substituted therefor the words “4th day of the month of December in that period”.
