**The Peterhead Harbour of Refuge (Port-Hand Rule)
Byelaws 1960 Revocation Byelaws 1974**

Made - - - 3rd May 1974

Coming into Operation 28th June 1974

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 83 of the Harbours, Docks and Piers Clauses Act 1847(a), as applied by sections 2 and 13 of the Peterhead Harbour of Refuge Act 1886(b), and by the said section 13 of the Peterhead Harbour of Refuge Act 1886, all as read with the Peterhead Harbour of Refuge (Transfer) Order 1960(c), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following byelaws:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These byelaws may be cited as the Peterhead Harbour of Refuge (Port-Hand Rule) Byelaws 1960, Revocation Byelaws 1974 and shall come into operation at 00.01 hours on the 28th day after confirmation by the Secretary of State for Trade.

Interpretation

2.—(1) The Peterhead Harbour of Refuge (Port-Hand Rule) Byelaws 1960(d) are hereby revoked.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of these byelaws as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if these byelaws and the byelaws hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.
