**The Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973  
(Commencement No. 2) Order 1974**

*Made* - - - 4th July 1974

*Coming into Operation* 26th July 1974

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 confirmed by the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order Confirmation Act 1973(a) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1974.

2. Section 54 (Charges for floating plant etc.) of the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 confirmed by the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order Confirmation Act 1973 shall come into operation on 26th July 1974.
