**The Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) (Amendment)
Regulations 1974**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, being Ministers designated (a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the Economic Community, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the said section 2(2) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) (Amendment) Regulations 1974, and shall come into operation on 1st September 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. The Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) Regulations 1973(d) shall be amended by adding at the end of the Schedule thereto (which refers to regulations of the European Communities, concerned with the production and marketing of wine and related products, which are to be enforced in the United Kingdom by the appropriate Minister or by defined local authorities) the items set forth in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) Regulations 1973 by adding to the Schedule thereto references to three recent regulations of the European Communities concerned with the production and marketing of wine and related products which are to be enforced in the United Kingdom by the appropriate Minister except in the case of sales by retail when they will be enforced by defined local authorities.

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
