**The Students' Allowances (Scotland) Amendment
Regulations 1974**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by paragraph (f) of section 75 of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(a) as substituted by section 12(1) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1969(b), and by sections 76(1) and 144(5) of said Act of 1962, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations, which may be cited as the Students' Allowances (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 1974 shall be construed as one with the Students' Allowances (Scotland) Regulations 1971(c) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 12th August 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of principal regulations

2. In regulation 4(2) of the principal regulations for the words "the holder and his parents" there shall be substituted the words "the holder, the holder's parents and the holder's spouse".
