MERCHANT SHIPPING**The Merchant Shipping Act 1970 (Commencement No. 2)****Order 1974**

Made - - - 11th July 1974

Coming into Operation 1st March 1974

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 101(4) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1970(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Act 1970 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1974.

2. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters specified in the second column of that Schedule) shall come into operation on 1st October 1974.
