The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows: ---

1. This order may be cited as the North West Water Authority (Bow- Citation and scar Borehole) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st August commence-1974.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, expressions Interpreto which meanings are assigned by the Third Schedule have the same tation, respective meanings and-

"the Authority" means the North West Water Authority;

"the deposited plan" means the plan prepared in duplicate, signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment, and marked "Plan referred to in the North West Water Authority (Bowscar Borehole) Order 1974", one duplicate of which is deposited and available for inspection at the offices of the Authority and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

"the Third Schedule" means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

"the undertaking" means the undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3. The Authority may, when they have acquired the necessary lands or Power to sufficient rights or interest therein-

- (a) continue and maintain the existing borehole constructed on or and maintain under the land described in Schedule 1 to this order;
- (b) construct and maintain on the said land a pumping station (to be known as "the Bowscar pumping station") and a borehole; and
