Regulations 1974**

Made - - - - - *27th August 1974*

Coming into Operation *4th September 1974*

The Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 7 of the Pensions Commutation Act 1871(a) and section 3 of the Pensions Commutation Act 1882(b), and now vested in him (c), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions Commutation (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1974, and shall come into operation on 4th September 1974.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Pensions Commutation Regulations 1968(e), as amended by the Pensions Commutation (Amendment) Regulations 1974(f), shall be further amended by substituting for the Table set out in Part I of the Schedule thereto the Table set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
