In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Sections 11 and 23(2) of and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Counter-Inflation Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This order, which may be cited as the Counter-Inflation (Residential Rents—Public Sector) (Scotland) (No. 2) Order 1974, applies to Scotland, and shall come into operation on 1st October 1974.

Interpretation

2.—(1) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(2) In this order—

“the principal order” means the Counter-Inflation (Residential Rents—Public Sector) (Scotland) Order 1974(c).

Variation of the Principal Order

3. The principal order shall be varied as follows—in article 2(2) in the definition of “the standstill period” for the words “31st December 1974” there shall be substituted the words “15th May 1975”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Counter-Inflation (Residential Rents—Public Sector) (Scotland) Order 1974 prohibited increases in rent for all houses let by local authorities in Scotland during the standstill period ending on 31st December 1974.

This order, which applies to Scotland, extends the standstill period to 15th May 1975.

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
