The Chester Water (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1974

Made - - - 17th October 1974 Coming into Operation 1st November 1974

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Chester Water (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1974.
- 2. The byelaws made on 20th December 1963 by the Chester Waterworks Company under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Chester Water (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1973 (c), remain in force until 19th December 1974, shall remain in force until 19th December 1975.
