**The Merchant Shipping (Fees for Seamen's Documents)
(Amendment) Regulations 1974**

Made - - - - 29th October 1974

Laid before Parliament 6th November 1974

Coming into Operation 1st December 1974

The Secretary of State, with the approval of the Treasury and in exercise of powers conferred by section 84 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1970(a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Fees for Seamen's Documents) (Amendment) Regulations 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Merchant Shipping (Fees for Seamen's Documents) Regulations 1972(d) shall be amended as follows:—

- (1) In regulation 2, "96 pence" shall be substituted for "60 pence";
- (2) In regulation 3, "97 pence" shall be substituted for "85 pence".
