**The Foreign Sea-Fishery Officers (International
Commission for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries
Scheme) Second Variation Order 1974**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland and Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 7(4) and 18(3) of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Foreign Sea-Fishery Officers (International Commission for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Scheme) Second Variation Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 3rd December 1974.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this Order “Principal Order” means the Foreign Sea-Fishery Officers (International Commission for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Scheme) Order 1971(b) as amended (c).

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Variation of Principal Order

3. Reservation (b) in Part I of Schedule 1 to the Principal Order shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order varies the Foreign Sea-Fishery Officers (International Commission for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Scheme) Order 1971. Poland has withdrawn its reservations to the Scheme of Joint Enforcement of the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Commission (set out in Part I of Schedule 1 to the Order) and is now allowing inspection of gear and catch below deck of Polish fishing vessels. This Order reciprocates these new arrangements entitling Polish inspectors to inspect gear and catch below deck of British fishing boats.
