The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Advocate, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 15(1) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971(a), as amended by the Transfer of Functions (Secretary of State and Lord Advocate) Order 1972(b), hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Misuse of Drugs Tribunals) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 30th December 1974.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Part I and Part II of Schedule 1 to the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971 shall have effect as if there were specified therein respectively the tribunals in England and Wales and in Scotland constituted under Part I of Schedule 3 to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971(d).
