COURT OF SESSION, SCOTLAND

Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 7) 1974

Made - - - - 10th December 1974

Coming into Operation 7th January 1975

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 16 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1. In the case of any decree or extract in an action commenced on or after 7th January 1975, the provisions of Rule 66 of the Rules of Court(b) shall not apply. Instead there shall be substituted a new Rule 66 as follows:—

“Where interest is included in or exigible under a decree or extract, it shall be deemed to be at the rate of eleven per centum per annum, unless otherwise stated.”

2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 7) 1974, and shall come into operation on 7th January 1975. And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Act of Sederunt.)

This Act of Sederunt prescribes that in the case of a decree or extract in an action commenced on or after 7th January 1975, the rate of interest shall be deemed to be 11 per cent unless otherwise stated.
