**The Remuneration of Teachers (Farm Institutes)
(Amendment No. 4) Order 1974**

Made - - - - 12th December 1974

Coming into Operation 13th December 1974

Whereas—

(1) the Committee constituted under section 1 of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965(a) (“the Act”) for the purpose of considering the remuneration of teachers in farm institutes and teachers of agricultural subjects on the staff of local education authorities (“the Committee”) have, in pursuance of section 2(2) of the Act, transmitted to the Secretary of State for Education and Science (“the Secretary of State”) recommendations agreed on by them with respect to the remuneration of such teachers;

(2) there are in force Orders made under section 2 of the Act with respect to the remuneration of teachers in farm institutes and teachers of agricultural subjects on the staff of local authorities, namely the Remuneration of Teachers (Farm Institutes) Order 1973(b), the Remuneration of Teachers (Farm Institutes) (Amendment) Order 1974(c), the Remuneration of Teachers (Farm Institutes) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1974(d) and the Remuneration of Teachers (Farm Institutes) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1974(e);

(3) it appears to the Secretary of State that effect can more conveniently be given to the recommendations of the Committee by amending the scales and other provisions set out in the document referred to in the said Orders, namely, the document published by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office on 16th July 1973 under the title “SCALES OF SALARIES FOR THE TEACHING STAFF OF FARM INSTITUTES AND FOR TEACHERS OF AGRICULTURAL (INCLUDING HORTICULTURAL) SUBJECTS, ENGLAND AND WALES, 1973” (“the Document”);

(4) in pursuance of section 2(5) of the Act the Secretary of State has prepared a draft Order (being the draft of this Order) setting out the amendment of the scales and other provisions which, in his opinion, is requisite for giving effect to the recommendations of the Committee; and

(5) the Secretary of State, as required by section 2(6) of the Act, has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft Order and the Committee have made no representations with respect thereto.

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 2(6) of the Act, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Farm Institutes) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 13th December 1974.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(a) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of document

3. The scales and other provisions set out in the Document are hereby amended so as to give effect to the provisions of this Order.

Special salary payment

4. A teacher who on 6th December 1974 was in full-time employment as a member of the teaching staff of a Farm Institute maintained by a local education authority or as a teacher of agricultural subjects (including horticultural and related subjects) on the staff of a local education authority shall be paid £100 in addition to any other remuneration payable to him by virtue of the document.
