CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1974

Made - - - - - 31st December 1974

Coming into Operation 21st January 1975

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 21st January, 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970(d), as amended(e), shall have effect as if in Group 5 of Schedule 1 the following were deleted, namely—

“Coal, coke obtained from coal and solid fuels manufactured wholly or mainly from coal A”

This Order amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970 by removing from control coal, coke obtained from coal and solid fuels manufactured wholly or mainly from coal.
