## The Cessation of Approved Institutions (Eastmore House)

## Order 1974

Made - - - 11th March 1974

Coming into Operation 1st April 1974

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of her powers under sections 46 and 69 of the Children and Young Persons Act 1969(a) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Cessation of Approved Institutions (Eastmore House) Order 1974, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Cessation as an approved institution*

2. It having appeared to the Secretary of State that in consequence of the establishment of community homes in Planning Area No. 10, as designated in the Children and Young Persons (Planning Areas) Order 1974(c) Eastmore House is no longer required, she hereby orders that it shall cease to be an approved institution as from 1st April 1974.

*Revocation of previous orders*

3. The Cessation of Approved Institutions (Eastmore House) Order 1973(d) and the Cessation of Approved Institutions (Eastmore House) (Amendment) Order 1973(e) are hereby revoked.
