PENSIONS

The Pensions Increase (Teachers) (Scotland) Regulations 1974

<i>Made- - - -</i>	17th May 1974
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	31st May 1974
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	21st June 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 1(1), (2) and (4) and 4(1) and (3)(a) of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1974(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf and with the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Pensions Increase (Teachers) (Scotland) Regulations 1974.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 21st June and shall have effect as from 1st December 1973.

(3) In these regulations—

“the Act” means the Pensions (Increase) Act 1974;

other expressions have the meanings assigned to them by the Teachers Superannuation (Scotland) Regulations 1969 to 1974(b).

(4) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prescription of Regulations

2. There are hereby prescribed for the purposes of section 1(1) of the Act pensions payable under regulations made or deemed to be made under section 9 of the Superannuation Act 1972(d) in its application to Scotland (“prescribed pensions”).

The relevant date

3. The date on which, in the opinion of the Secretary of State, the emoluments relevant for the purpose of calculating any prescribed pension are expected to be increased by the principal pay increase expected to be made, during the year ending with 6th November 1974, in accordance with the code in force under section 2 of the Counter-Inflation Act 1973(e) at the time of the increase is 1st April 1974.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations enable pensions payable to or in respect of teachers to be increased under section 1 of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1974, which provides for increases in official pensions affected by the Counter-Inflation Act 1973. By virtue of section 4(3)(a) of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1974 these Regulations have retrospective effect to 1st December 1973.
