**The Trustee Savings Banks (Special Investments) (Limits)
(Revocation) Order 1974**
*Laid before Parliament in draft**Made - - - - 29th May 1974**Coming into Operation 6th June 1974*

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 17 of the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1969(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trustee Savings Banks (Special Investments) (Limits) (Revocation) Order 1974, and shall come into operation on 6th June 1974.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Trustee Savings Banks (Special Investments) (Limits) Order 1960(c), the Trustee Savings Banks (Special Investments) (Limits) (Amendment) Order 1961(d) and the Trustee Savings Banks (Special Investments) (Limits) (Amendment) Order 1969(e) are hereby revoked.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Trustee Savings Banks (Special Investments) (Limits) Order 1960, as amended, imposed a limit of £10,000 on the amount which might be received by a trustee savings bank from any person for special investment. This Order revokes the 1960 Order, thus removing the limit.
