EXPENSES****The Coroners (Fees and Allowances) (Amendment) Rules 1974**

Made - - - 22nd May 1974

Coming into Operation 10th June 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(1) of the Coroners Act 1954(a), I hereby make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Coroners (Fees and Allowances) (Amendment) Rules 1974 and shall come into operation on 10th June 1974.

2. Rule 4(3) of the Coroners (Fees and Allowances) Rules 1971(b) as amended (c), shall be amended by the substitution of the words “6·6p” for the words “6p”.

3. Rule 10(3)(b) of the said Rules, as amended (d), shall be amended by the substitution of the words “4·8p”, “6p” and “6·6p” respectively for the words “4·4p”, “5·5p” and “6·0p”.
