The Secretary of State, having consulted the Advisory Committee established under section 3 of the Animals (Restriction of Importation) Act 1964(a), in exercise of the powers contained in section 2 of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals (Restriction of Importation) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 18th July 1975.

Modification of Schedule to Act

2. There shall be added to the Schedule to the said Act (which specifies the kinds of animals the importation of individuals whereof is restricted)—

Alligatoridae,
Crocodylidae,
Gavialidae,
Emydidae.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits the importation of all live animals of the alligator, crocodile and gavial families and of one turtle family save under the authority, and in accordance with the terms, of a licence.
