## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (No. 4)  
Order 1975**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	23rd June 1975
<i>Laid before the House of Commons</i>	1st July 1975
<i>Coming into Operation</i> - - -	22nd July 1975

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 10(3) and 15(4) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (No. 4) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 22nd July 1975.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The anti-dumping duty imposed by the Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 2) Order 1971(d) on moving eyes for dolls, other than eyes made of glass, originating in the United States of America and being products of Jacoby-Bender Incorporated (trading as the Dollac Company of New York) or the Margon Corporation of New Jersey, which was temporarily suspended by the Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (No. 3) Order 1974(e) for a period of twelve months beginning with 22nd July 1974, shall not be chargeable on moving eyes for dolls imported into the United Kingdom during a period of twelve months beginning with the date of coming into operation of this Order.
