**The Northern Ireland Act 1974  
(Interim Period Extension) Order 1975***Laid before Parliament in draft**Made* - - - - - *27th June 1975**Coming into Operation* *27th June 1975*

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Merlyn Rees, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(4) of the Northern Ireland Act 1974 (a), hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland Act 1974 (Interim Period Extension) Order 1975 and shall come into operation forthwith.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 (b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The interim period specified by section 1(4) of the Northern Ireland Act 1974 shall continue until 16th July 1976.
