**The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Detrunking from
Aston Hill to Waterstock Crossroads) Order 1975**

Made - - - 19th June 1975

Coming into Operation 29th July 1975

The Secretary of State for the Environment makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 7 of the Highways Act 1959(a), section 27 of the Local Government Act 1966(b) and now vested in him(c), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The length of trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road as from the date on which this Order comes into operation.

2. In this Order—

“the deposited plan” means the plan numbered HA7/2–E96 marked “The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Detrunking from Aston Hill to Waterstock Crossroads) Order 1975”, signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of the Environment, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London SE1 0TE, where it may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours;

“principal road” as a classification for a highway, means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of advances under section 235 of the Highways Act 1959 and is also classified for the purposes of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State;

“the Trunk Road” means the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A40).

3. This Order shall come into operation on 29th July 1975 and may be cited as the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Detrunking from Aston Hill to Waterstock Crossroads) Order 1975.

THE SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

The length of trunk road ceasing to be a trunk road is that length of the Trunk Road which is situated between the Oxfordshire County Boundary at Aston Hill and Waterstock Crossroads, Oxfordshire.
