The Import Duties (Quota Relief) Order 1975

Made - - - - 4th August 1975

*Laid before the
House of Commons* - 4th August 1975

Coming into Operation 5th August 1975

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5(1) and (4) of, and paragraph 8 of Schedule 3 to, the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Quota Relief) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 5th August 1975.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Schedule 2 to the Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 9) Order 1974(d) shall be amended as follows:

(a) in column 3 after “3110/74 (O.J. No. L337, 16.12.74.)” there shall be inserted “as amended by 1910/75 (O.J. No. L195, 26.7.75)”;

(b) in column 1 for “Handwoven pile fabrics and chenille fabrics (other than terry products of cotton falling within heading No. 55.08 and fabrics falling within heading No. 58.05)” there shall be substituted “Handwoven pile fabrics and chenille fabrics of cotton (other than terry towelling or similar terry products falling within heading No. 55.08 and fabrics falling within heading No. 58.05)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 5th August 1975, amends the Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 9) Order 1974 in relation to the tariff quotas for certain handwoven fabrics. The Community Instrument specified in the 1974 Order under which these two tariff quotas were opened has been amended by a further Community Instrument, specified in this Order, which increases the amount of the tariff quota for certain handwoven silk fabrics and also changes the description of certain handwoven fabrics falling within tariff heading 58.04 to make it clear that they are of cotton.

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
