The Independent Schools Tribunal (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1975

Made - - - 31st July 1975

Coming into Operation 30th August 1975

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 75(1) of the Education Act 1944(a) and with the concurrence of the Lord President of the Council and the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of the powers now vested in him(b), hereby makes the following Rules:—

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Independent Schools Tribunal (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1975 and shall come into operation on 30th August 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) In these Rules “the principal Rules” means the Independent Schools Tribunal Rules 1958(d), as amended(e).

2. In rule 13(1) of the principal Rules for the figure “£12.60” there shall be substituted the figure “£16”.

3. Paragraph (2) of the Second Schedule to the principal Rules shall be amended as follows:—

(a) in sub-paragraph (a), for the figures “£0.71” and “£1.50” there shall be substituted the figures “£0.85” and “£1.80” respectively;

(b) in sub-paragraph (b), for the figures “£12.35” and “£11.30” there shall be substituted the figures “£16.55” and “£14.65” respectively.
