The Police Cadets (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1975.

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>11th August 1975</i>

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 35 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1975.
2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st September 1975.
3. In these Regulations a reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets Regulations 1968(c), as amended(d).
4. Regulation 8 of the Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1974(e) (supplementary pay related to Retail Price Index figure) is hereby revoked.
5. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (scales of pay) there shall be substituted the following Table:—

Age	City of London and metropolitan police forces	Other police forces
Under 17 years	£1,302 a year	£1,137 a year
17 years	£1,371 a year	£1,206 a year
18 years	£1,509 a year	£1,344 a year
19 years	£1,545 a year	£1,380 a year"

6. For paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations (charges for board and lodging) there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“2. The annual rate of charge shall be—

(a) in the case of a police cadet attached to the City of London or metropolitan police force, £177;

(b) in any other case, £165”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Cadets Regulations 1968.

Regulations 4 and 5 increase the pay of a police cadet by amounts which vary according to his age and provide for the termination of “threshold” payments.

Regulation 6 increases charges payable by police cadets for board and lodging.
