

**1975 No. 1440****DESIGNS****The Designs (Amendment No. 3) Rules 1975**

*Rule 3* - - - - 10th December 1975

The Secretary of State in exercise of powers conferred by sections 36 and 40 of the Registered Designs Act 1949(a), as amended by the Patents and Designs (Renewals, Extensions and Fees) Act 1961(b), and now vested in him (c), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Designs (Amendment No. 3) Rules 1975 and shall come into operation on 10th September 1975, except in the case of Rule 3, which shall do so on 10th December 1975.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if these Rules and the Rules hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

3. On 10th December 1975, for Schedule 1 to the Designs Rules 1949(e), as amended (f), there shall be substituted the Schedule hereto and the Designs (Amendment) Rules 1975(g) shall thereupon be revoked.

4. Where on or after 10th September 1975 but before 10th December 1975, an application is made for an extension of the period of copyright in any registered design in respect of which the period of copyright current is due to expire on or after 10th December 1975, the fee payable shall be that which would be payable if the application were made on or after 10th December 1975 and Rule 3 of these Rules had come into operation.

These Rules further amend the Designs Rules 1949 so as to increase certain fees payable under the Act with effect from 10th December 1975, except in the case of fees paid in advance for the extension of the copyright period in a design in respect of any period beginning on or after 10th December 1975, which are increased with effect from 10th September 1975.

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
