The Sheriff Court Districts (Amendment) Order 1975

Made - - - - 16th September 1975

Coming into Operation 1st November 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1971(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Sheriff Court Districts (Amendment) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1975.

2.—(1) In this order any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or extended by or under any other enactment.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Sheriff Court Districts Reorganisation Order 1975(c) is hereby amended by substituting in column 3 of the Schedule thereto—

(a) for the description of the new sheriff court district of Cupar the words “The district of North East Fife”; and

(b) for the description of the new sheriff court district of Kirkcaldy the words “The district of Kirkcaldy”.
