The Remuneration of Teachers (Primary and Secondary Schools)

No. 2 Order 1975

*Made - - - - 25th September 1975**Coming into Operation 26th September 1975*

Whereas—

- (1) in pursuance of section 3(1) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965^(a) (“the Act”) certain matters in respect of which agreement had not been reached in the Committee constituted under section 1 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration payable to teachers in primary and secondary schools maintained by local education authorities (“the Committee”) were referred to arbitration;
- (2) in pursuance of section 2(2) of the Act the Committee transmitted to the Secretary of State for Education and Science (“the Secretary of State”) recommendations agreed on by them with respect to certain other matters affecting the remuneration of such teachers;
- (3) in pursuance of section 2(3) of the Act, the Secretary of State has prepared a draft document setting out the scales and other provisions required for determining the remuneration of teachers of the description aforesaid in the form in which, in his opinion, those scales and provisions should be so as to give effect to the recommendations of the arbitrators and of the Committee;
- (4) the Secretary of State, as required by section 2(4) of the Act, has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft document and made such modifications thereof as were requisite for giving effect to representations made by the Committee; and
- (5) the Secretary of State has arranged for a document setting out the requisite scales and other provisions in the form of the draft as modified as aforesaid to be published by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office on 24th September 1975 under the title “SCALES OF SALARIES FOR TEACHERS IN PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS, ENGLAND AND WALES, 1975”.

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in pursuance of sections 2(4) and 4(1) of the Act, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Primary and Secondary Schools) No. 2 Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 26th September 1975.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(a) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament; and section 38(2) (effect of repeals) of that Act shall have effect in relation to the Order specified in Article 4 of this Order as if it were an enactment repealed by an Act.

Remuneration of Teachers

3. The remuneration payable from 1st March 1975 to teachers in primary and secondary schools maintained by local education authorities shall be determined in accordance with the scales and other provisions set out in the document published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office as aforesaid.

Revocation

4. The Remuneration of Teachers (Primary and Secondary Schools) Order 1975(b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation the scales and other provisions relating to the remuneration of teachers in primary and secondary schools maintained by local education authorities set out in a document published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office. This document gives effect both to the recommendations agreed by the Committee constituted under the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965 for the consideration of the remuneration of such teachers and to the recommendations of arbitrators appointed under that Act.

The Order has retrospective effect from 1st March 1975 by virtue of section 7(3) of the Act.
