**The Trunk Road (Eastern Avenue, Ilford) (Prescribed Route)
Order 1975**

Made - - - 16th September 1975

Coming into Operation 21st September 1975

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b) and of Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974(c), and now vested in him(d), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Secretary of State for the Home Department, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (Eastern Avenue, Ilford) (Prescribed Route) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 21st September 1975.

2.—(1) In this Order:—

“Eastern Avenue” means that length of the London–Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (A12) in the London Borough of Redbridge known as Eastern Avenue;

“central reservation” means the provision made in Eastern Avenue for separating a part of the carriageway which is to be used by traffic proceeding in one direction from a part of the carriageway which is to be used by traffic proceeding in the opposite direction.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in the eastbound carriageway of Eastern Avenue to turn into the westbound carriageway of Eastern Avenue at the eastern end of the central reservation, which end lies 76 feet south-west of the centre of the southernmost point of the northbound carriageway of Aldborough Road North, so as to proceed in the opposite direction to that in which it was proceeding.

4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden.
