The Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (Revocation) **Order 1975**

Made -22nd October 1975

Laid before the

House of Commons 23rd October 1975

Coming into Operation 1st November 1975

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 10(3) and 15(4) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (Revocation) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1975.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (No. 2) Order 1975(d) (which suspended for a period of twelve months beginning with 1st March 1975 the anti-dumping duties imposed by the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973(e) on saccharin and its salts originating in Japan or the Republic of Korea) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (No. 2) Order 1975, which suspended the anti-dumping duties imposed by the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973 on saccharin and its salts originating in Japan or the Republic of Korea.
