EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES
The Further Education (Transitional Exemption Orders)
Regulations 1975

Made - - - - 24th November 1975
Laid before Parliament 5th December 1975
Coming into Operation 29th December 1975

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 100 of the Education Act 1944(a) as extended by paragraph 3 of schedule 2 to the Sex Discrimination Act 1975(b) and by section 5(2) of the Local Government Act 1974(c) as extended by paragraph 4 of that schedule and vested in him(d), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Further Education (Transitional Exemption Orders) Regulations 1975 and shall come into operation on 29th December 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Transitional exemption orders

2.—(1) There shall be added to Part II of the Further Education Regulations 1975(f) as a new regulation—

“6A.—(1) The Secretary of State may, on the application of the authority maintaining an establishment which is a single sex establishment within the meaning of the Sex Discrimination Act 1975, make an order authorising discriminatory admissions to the establishment during the transitional period specified in the order.

(2) An application for an order under this regulation shall specify—

- (a) the transitional period during which the authority propose that discriminatory admissions should be authorised by the order;
- (b) the stages by which the authority propose that the establishment should move to a position where section 26(1) of the Sex Discrimination Act 1975 ceases to apply to it; and
- (c) any other matters relevant to the terms and operation of the order applied for.”

(2) In regulation 21 of the Further Education Regulations 1975 immediately after "Regulation 6" there shall be inserted "6A".

These Regulations provide for the making of orders by the Secretary of State authorising discriminatory admission to single sex establishments of further education during a transitional period so as to enable them to become fully co-educational by stages.
