The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Advocate, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 15(1) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971(a), as amended by the Transfer of Functions (Secretary of State and Lord Advocate) Order 1972(b), hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Child Interim Benefit Appeals) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 2nd January 1976.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Part I of Schedule 1 to the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971 shall have effect as if there were specified therein the tribunals constituted by the Child Interim Benefit (Determination of Questions) Regulations 1975(\mathbf{d}) and any person appointed under section 16(7)(\mathbf{b}) of the Child Benefit Act 1975(\mathbf{e}) to hear appeals from such tribunals (referred to in the said Regulations as "the Referee").
