## JUSTICES OF THE PEACE

The Justices Allowances (Scotland) Amendment  
Regulations 1975

Made - - - - 18th November 1975  
Laid before Parliament 5th December 1975  
Coming into Operation 26th December 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 17 of the District Courts (Scotland) Act 1975(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Justices Allowances (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1975, and shall come into operation on 26th December 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In Schedule 3 to the Justices Allowances (Scotland) Regulations 1975(c) (which sets out the rate of financial loss allowance payable to justices of the peace) for the expressions “£3·35” and “£6·70”, there shall be substituted the expressions “£4·00” and “£8·00” respectively.
