**The National Health Service (Remission of Charges)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1975**

Coming into Operation 1st January 1976

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of powers conferred by section 3(2)(b) (as amended by section 39(1) of the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968(a) and section 57(1) of and paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 4 to the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973(b)), and section 44(1)(b) (as amended by the said section 39(1)) of the National Health Service Act 1946(c) and section 1(2) of the National Health Service Act 1952(d) and now vested in her (e) and of powers conferred on her by sections 50(1) and 56(4) of the said Act of 1973, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Remission of Charges) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1976.

Amendments to Regulations

2. In regulation 6(1)(b)(i) of the National Health Service (Remission of Charges) Regulations 1974(f) (as amended) (g), for the amount “£1.50” there shall be substituted the amount “£2.50”.
