(Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1975***Made - - - - - 4th December 1975**Laid before Parliament 11th December 1975**Coming into Operation 1st January 1976*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 11(3)(a) of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1976.

2. The Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) Regulations 1975(b), as amended (c), shall have effect as though in Article 4 (fee for certificates) the figure of £30 were replaced by the figure of £12.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations provide for the reduction from £30 to £12 in the fee to be paid on application for a certificate of compulsory insurance under section 11 of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971. The reduction takes effect on 1st January 1976.
