Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) No. 5 Order 1975

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and having been satisfied as respects the area hereinafter mentioned that certain waters therein are infected waters, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) No. 5 Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 10th December 1975.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Infected area

3. The area comprising Kenmuir Fishery, New Galloway, Kirkcudbrightshire, and the stream flowing therefrom to the south and east to the point at which it flows into Little Kenmure Loch is hereby declared to be an infected area for the purpose of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

Control of movement of fish etc.

4. No person shall without the previous consent in writing of the Secretary of State move out of the area declared by Article 3 above to be an infected area any live fish, or eggs of fish or foodstuff for fish.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order declares Kenmuir Fishery, New Galloway, Kirkcudbrightshire to be an infected area for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937 and prohibits the movement out of the area of any live fish, eggs of fish, or foodstuff for fish.
