CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Import Duties (Quota Relief) (Paper, Paperboard and Printed Products) Order 1975

Made - - - - 9th December 1975

Laid before the House of Commons 11th December 1975

Coming into Operation - - 1st January 1976

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5(1) and (4) of, and paragraph 8 of Schedule 3 to, the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended by paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to the European Communities Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order.

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Quota Relief) (Paper, Paperboard and Printed Products) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1976.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - (3) In this Order—
 - "the Agreements" means the Agreements, signed on 22nd July 1972, between the European Economic Community and, respectively, Austria, Iceland, Portugal, Sweden and Switzerland, the Agreement, signed on 14th May 1973, between the Community and Norway and the Agreement, signed on 5th October 1973, between the Community and Finland(d) and references to an Agreement shall be construed accordingly;
 - references to goods originating in any of the above-mentioned countries are references to products which, under the provisions of the Agreements, are to be regarded as originating there.
- 2.—(1) Up to and including 31st December 1976, no import duty shall be charged on the relevant quota of goods which—
 - (a) fall within a heading or subheading of the Customs Tariff 1959 specified in column 3 of any of the Schedules hereto,
 - (b) are of a description specified in column 1 of such a Schedule in relation to the heading or subheading and

- (c) originate in the country to which the Schedule relates and satisfy the provisions of Article 25(1) of Protocol No. 3 (relating to origin of goods) to the Agreement between the Community and that country as amended(a).
- (2) For the purposes of this Article, the "relevant quota" of goods of a description specified in column 1 of any Schedule hereto is the quantity of goods specified in column 2 of such a Schedule in relation to the description (such quantities being expressed as a number of tonnes or a value in pounds), and any entry in column 2 of a Schedule prescribing a limit to a subclass of goods within a quota shall have effect.
- (3) The Schedules to this Order relate to the countries named in Article 1(3) above as follows:

Schedule 1 to Austria,

Schedule 2 to Iceland,

Schedule 3 to Portugal,

Schedule 4 to Sweden,

Schedule 5 to Switzerland,

Schedule 6 to Norway and

Schedule 7 to Finland.

- (4) Goods shall be treated as forming part of a quota in the order in which the importer delivers an entry thereof for home use (within the meaning of section 28 of the Customs and Excise Act 1952(b) and Regulation 8 of the Warehousing Regulations 1975(c)) containing a claim for relief from import duty under the quota in the United Kingdom on or after 1st January 1976.
- 3. A description of goods in column 1 or 2 of any of the Schedules hereto, other than one covering a whole heading or subheading, shall be taken to comprise all goods which would be classified under a description in the same terms constituting a subheading in the relevant heading of the Customs Tariff 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st January 1976, provides for the opening and administration during 1976 of duty-free tariff quotas for paper, paperboard and printed products originating in Austria, Iceland, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland, Norway and Finland authorised to be opened by the Agreements between the European Economic Community and those countries. In order to qualify for duty-free treatment within the quotas goods must satisfy the conditions relating to origin in Article 25(1) of Protocol 3 to the Agreements. Goods are treated as forming part of a quota in the order in which an entry for home use is made containing a claim for relief from import duty.

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
