The Control of Pollution Act 1974 (Commencement No. 3)

Order 1975

Made - - - - - 21st February 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 109(2) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Control of Pollution Act 1974 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1975.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Section 108(2) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 so far as it applies to the repeal effected by Schedule 4 thereof to section 135(3) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(c) shall come into operation on 3rd March 1975.
