# The North East River Purification Board (Establishment) Order 1975

Made -Coming into Operation 21st February 1975

7th March 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 135 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) and by sections 6 and 7 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) (Scotland) Act 1951(b) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, after consultation with all local authorities and river purification boards whose areas are wholly or partly within the area affected by this order and having complied with the provisions of Schedule 3 to the Water (Scotland) Act 1967(c) as applied by subsection (7) of the said section 135, I hereby make the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the North East River Purification Board (Establishment) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 7th March 1975.
  - 2.—(1) In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

"the Act" means the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973;

"the Act of 1947" means the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1947(d):

"the Act of 1951" means the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) (Scotland) Act 1951:

"the Board" means the North East River Purification Board established by article 3 of this order;

"North East River Purification Board Area" means the area so described and defined in the Order of 1975;

"the Order of 1975" means the River Purification Board Areas (Scotland) Order 1975(e):

"proper officer" means in relation to any purpose, an officer appointed for that purpose by the Board;

"river purification authorities" means the river purification authorities which before 16th May 1975 exercised functions under the Act of 1951 and the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) (Scotland) Act 1965(f) over the area described in paragraph iv of the Schedule to the Order of 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(g) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

- 3.—(1) There shall be a river purification board for the North East River Purification Board Area which shall be a body corporate and shall be known as the North East River Purification Board.
- (2) The Board shall have a common seal and may hold land and may sue and be sued in their own name.
- (3) The Board shall consist of 18 members, of whom the Secretary of State shall appoint 6 in accordance with the provisions of section 135(5)(b) of the Act and each local authority or group of authorities specified in column (1) below shall appoint from among their members such number of members as are specified opposite and in relation to that local authority in column (2)—

- (4) (a) Members of the Board appointed by the local authorities as specified in paragraph (3) above shall be appointed within one month after the coming into operation of this order and thereafter within one month of each ordinary election of councillors and shall serve on the Board for their terms of office as councillors in accordance with the provisions of section 4 of the Act;
- (b) upon a person appointed by a local authority or group of local authorities ceasing to be a member of the Board otherwise than on the expiry of his term of membership under subparagraph (a) above, the council or councils by which he was appointed shall appoint a member in his stead; provided that such appointment need not be made if it falls to be made within 6 months of the date of the next ordinary election;
  - (c) members of the Board will be eligible for re-appointment;
- (d) for any member appointed by a council or councils under paragraph (3) above a substitute member may also be appointed by that council or councils and such a substitute member may attend any meeting and shall have the same voting powers as the member whose place he has been appointed to occupy.
- 4.—(1) The first meeting of the Board shall be held not later than 6 weeks after the coming into operation of this order and shall be convened by the Chief Executive of the district of the City of Aberdeen.
- (2) Each authority or group of authorities appointing members under article 3(3) above, immediately after making the appointments, shall inform the Chief Executive of the district of the City of Aberdeen of the names of their appointed members.
- 5.—(1) The provisions of sections 260 to 296 of the Act of 1947 (which relate to borrowing by local authorities) shall, in their application by virtue of section 7 of the Act of 1951 to borrowing by the Board, have effect subject to the modifi-

cations specified in column (2) in Part I of the Schedule to this order and in the next succeeding paragraph.

- (2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in the said sections—
  - (a) to the Act of 1947, shall be construed as a reference to that Act as modified by this order;
  - (b) to Part XII of the Act of 1947, shall be construed as a reference to section 7 of the Act of 1951 and to the said sections 260 to 296 as modified by this order;
  - (c) to a local authority, shall be construed as a reference to the Board;
  - (d) to the clerk or treasurer of a local authority, shall be construed as a reference to the proper officer of the Board.
- 6. The provisions of the Act set out in column (1) in Part II of the Schedule to this order shall apply in relation to the Board subject to the modifications, specified opposite and in relation thereto in column (2) of the said Part and, except in the application of section 65 and where the context otherwise requires, for any reference to a local authority, authority, or council in the said provisions there shall be substituted a reference to the Board.
- 7.—(1) For the purposes of section 6(1) of the Act of 1951, the Board's expenses shall be defrayed by the councils of the regions whose areas are comprised wholly or partly in the river purification board area and shall be apportioned and allocated among the said regions in the proportion which the product of a rate of one penny in the pound or the standard penny rate product, whichever is the higher, estimated in accordance with the provisions of section 12 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1966(a) for so much of the area of each of the said regions as lies within the area of the Board, bears to the sum of the said rate products of one penny in the pound or standard penny rate products as the case may be for all the said areas of the said regions.
- (2) The Board shall issue requisitions to the councils for the payment of the amount apportioned to the said councils.
- 8.—(1) All the rights and liabilities other than those in or relating to property of the river purification authorities arising in connection with the discharge of their functions over so much of the area of the said authorities as lies within the area described in paragraph iv of the Schedule to the Order of 1975 shall be transferred to and vest in the Board with effect from 16th May 1975, without the necessity of any conveyance or other process of law.
- (2) Where any such right or liability vests in the Board, the Board and all other persons shall have the same rights, powers and remedies (and, in particular, the same rights as to the taking or resisting of legal or other proceedings) for ascertaining, completing or enforcing that right or liability as they would have had if it had at all times been a right or liability of the Board.
- (3) Any legal or other proceedings arising in connection with the discharge of their functions over so much of the area of the said river purification authorities as lies within the area described in paragraph iv of the Schedule to the Order of 1975, to which any of the said river purification authorities are a party and which are pending on 16th May 1975, may be continued on and after that day

as if the Board instead of any of the said river purification authorities had been a party thereto.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order establishes a river purification board to be known as the North East River Purification Board for the area defined in the River Purification Board Areas (Scotland) Order 1975. It specifies the total number of members for the Board and details the number of members who are to be appointed respectively by the councils of the regions and of the districts which fall wholly or partly within the area, and specifies their term of office.

The Order also makes arrangements for the calling of the first meeting of the Board and for the financing of the Board. It also applies to the Board, with modifications, certain provisions of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 and transfers to the Board the rights and liabilities of the river purification authorities which, before 16th May 1975, exercised river purification functions over the Board's area.
