The Rate Support Grant (Increase) (Scotland) (No. 2)

Order 1975

Made - - - - 9th January 1975

Laid before the Commons
House of Parliament - 20th January 1975

Coming into Operation 29th January 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1966(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, since it appears to me that there has been an unforeseen increase in the level of prices, costs and remuneration affecting substantially the reckonable expenditure of local authorities for the year 1974-75, with the consent of the Treasury and after consultation with such associations of local authorities as appear to me to be concerned in accordance with the provisions of section 3 of the Act, I hereby make the following order:—

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Rate Support Grant (Increase) (Scotland) (No. 2) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on the day following the day on which it is approved by a resolution of the Commons House of Parliament.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) In this order “the Act” means the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1966.

Aggregate Grants

2. For the amount prescribed by the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) Order 1974(c) for the purposes of rate support grants for the year 1974-75 in respect of the matters indicated in column (1) of the following table, being the amounts set out in column (2) thereof, there shall be substituted the amounts specified in column (3) thereof—

(a) 1966 c. 51.

(b) 1889 c. 63.
