**The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits)
(Scotland) Order 1975**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>14th April 1975</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>25th April 1975</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st May 1975</i>

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 49(3C) of the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963(a), which is set out in Part I of Schedule 11 to the Gaming Act 1968(b), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) (Scotland) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1975.

2. The provisions of subsection (3) of section 49 of the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963 (which sets out the conditions on which the provision of amusements with prizes is permitted at certain commercial entertainments) shall have effect as if—

- (a) the sum of 10p were substituted for the sum of one shilling specified in paragraph (a) thereof;
- (b) the sum of £5 were substituted for the sum of fifty shillings specified in paragraph (b) thereof; and
- (c) the sum of 10p were substituted for the sum of one shilling specified in paragraph (c) thereof.
